Minor Water Withdrawal

Dear Lakefront Property Owner:

Thank you for your interest in utilizing a Duke Energy reservoir as a source of water for use with your landscape irrigation system. The guidelines for minor water withdrawals are included in the Miscellaneous Reservoir Uses Program portion of the Shoreline Management Guidelines. In order for Lake Services to adequately review your proposal we ask that you submit the following:

1. A sketch showing the proposed line and pump locations in the lake from the Project Boundary lakeward.
2. Copy of a registered survey of the property, showing proposal's location from your property into the project boundary.
3. A statement verifying the pump's rated horsepower (2 horsepower maximum), and the intended use of the water withdrawn.
4. Private Facilities User's Agreement Letter.
5. Directions by road to the property where the permit is being requested.

Duke Energy Lake Services will review the merits of the proposal and provide written authorization if the proposal is approved. The applicant will be required to maintain the system appropriately to ensure it does not become a hazard to navigation or public safety, and restore the area at the end of the proposal's life.
